2nd Norms–Indulgences At The Commemoration Of All Souls:

1. From 12 o'clock noon on 1 November. until midnight on 2 November all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (1 Our father & Hail Mary or any other Prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a Church or Oratory, and there reciting one Our Father & the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following the 1 November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1–8 November. 2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1–8 November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.
