A Miracle Attributed To The Intercession Of Cardinal:

John Henry Newman has been recognized clearing him for canonization. He was born in London on 21 Feb. 1801. He died in Edgbaston on 11 Aug. 1890. The noted theologian/poet was first an Anglican priest and later a Catholic priest & cardinal. He was beatified by Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI in Sept. 2010. Pope Francis signed the decree for canonization on Tues. 12 Feb.
