St. Augustine's NS - The Kakhuma Project is a group of more than 100 teachers in 40 countries offering a free education to children in the camp via Skype. Mrs Murray and Ms. Scott will be involved from next September.

In Kakhuma teachers can have between 150 to 200 students each with only one textbook between ten students. The money raised will be used to buy textbooks and laptops for use in the camp school.

The Camp houses over 200,000 refugees who fled war and hunger in Somalia, Burundi Sudan and DR Congo. 55% of the refugees are children.
