The 'Stop Food Waste' seminar by Galway CoCo Sustainability Group continues this Thursday 9th May at 8.30-9.30pm in Lawrencetown Hall. This is a 4 week programme which will teach us about reducing food waste, home composting and reducing unnecessary hazardous chemicals in the home. Irish householders are challenged to set themselves a target to reduce their food waste by at least 1/4.
