There will be adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament in Lawrencetown church tomorrow (Monday) from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and in Kiltormer church on Thursday from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Please give some of this time to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.

Next Wednesday is the feast of All Saints and is a holy day of obligation. Masses will be at 8.00 p.m. on Tuesday in Kiltormer and at 11.30 a.m. on Wednesday in Lawrencetown.

Next Thursday is the feast of All Souls. Masses will be in Kiltormer at 6.00 p.m. and in Lawrencetown at 7.00 p.m. The All Souls collection is taken up on Wednesday. I will offer ten Masses for those whose names are on the lists that are enclosed with the November offerings.

Next Friday is the first Friday of November. First Friday Holy Communion calls will begin as usual at 9.30 a.m.

From 12 o'clock noon on 1 Nov. until midnight on 2 Nov., you can gain *one* plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Holy Souls, by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting the Our Father and the Apostles' Creed. If you visit a cemetery and pray for the dead, you may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls, *once per day* from 1 to 8 Nov. The conditions for these indulgences are Confession (at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1 Nov.), Holy Communion (on any day from 1 to 8 Nov.) and prayer for the Pope's intentions (Our Father and Hail Mary, or any prayer of one's choice).
