Holy Souls

From 12 o'clock noon on 1st November until mid-night, 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (One Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church, or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following the 1st November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st November - 8th November. For every other visit to the Church made during this time a partial indulgence for the same intention may be gained. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st- 8th November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.
