**NORMS FOR INDULGENCES: 1<sup>ST</sup> Nov Feast of All Saints and is a Holy Day of Obligation. 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov Feast of All Souls. From Noon on 1<sup>st</sup> Nov until Midnight on 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov one can gain a plenary indulgence applicable to the Holy Souls by visiting a Church or Oratory and there reciting One Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.**

**Confessions maybe made at anytime with the week proceeding or the week following the 1<sup>st</sup> Nov. Holy Communion maybe received on any day from 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Nov. The faithful who will visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls of the usual conditions once per day from 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> Nov. Conditions mentioned above apply also to this.**
