For the applicant to receive works, they must **NOT** have received works under the SEAI scheme previously. If all the criteria are met, works such as attic insulation and ventilation, cavity wall insulation and ventilation, draught proofing, lagging jackets, cold water storage jackets, pipe lagging, energy advice and BER's can be installed in the applicant's home **FREE** of charge.
